WORKERS' COMPENSATION. Provides for reciprocity with states who apply Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law to a complaint filed in that state by a professional athlete injured while employed by a Louisiana employer. (8/15/10)

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 23:1035.3, relative to reciprocity; to provide for reciprocity with states who
3	apply Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law to a complaint filed in that state by a
4	professional athlete injured in Louisiana; to provide for a process to implement
5	reciprocity; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 23:1035.3 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1035.3. Workers' compensation reciprocity with respect to professional
9	<u>athletes</u>
10	A. If a professional athlete who has been hired or is regularly employed
11	in Louisiana receives a work related injury by accident arising out of and in the
12	course of such employment outside of Louisiana, he, or his dependents in the
13	case of his death, shall be entitled to compensation according to the laws of
14	Louisiana.
15	B. The employer of a professional athlete who has been hired outside of
16	Louisiana by an employer domiciled outside of this state shall be exempted from
17	the provisions of this Chapter while such professional athlete is temporarily

within Louisiana doing work for his employer, if such employer has furnished workers' compensation insurance coverage under the workers' compensation insurance or similar laws of a state other than Louisiana, so as to cover such professional athlete's employment while in this state; provided, that Subsection A of this Section is recognized in such other state and provided employers and professional athletes who are covered in this state are likewise exempted from the application of workers' compensation insurance of similar laws of such other state. The benefits under this Title, R.S. 23:1 et seq., or similar laws of such state, or other remedies under such act or such laws, shall be the exclusive remedy against such employer for any injury, whether resulting in death or not, received by a professional athlete while working for such employer in Louisiana.

C. A certificate from the duly authorized officer of the insurance commissioner or similar department of another state certifying that the employer of such other state is insured therein and has provided extraterritorial coverage insuring his professional athlete employees while working within this state shall be prima facie evidence that such employer carries such workers' compensation insurance.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> contains no provisions related to reciprocity in workers' compensation matters involving professional athletes in Louisiana.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides reciprocity to states who apply Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law when adjudicating a claim filed by a professional athlete injured while employed in Louisiana.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the filing of a certificate evidencing workers' compensation coverage for professional athletes working in Louisiana.

Effective August 15, 2010.
