FISH/FISHING. Provides for the possession limits of crappie on Lake D'Arbonne. (8/1/14)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 56:325(B)(3), relative to the possession limit for crappie in
3 certain water bodies; to provide a fifty fish limit for crappie caught on Lake
4 D'Arbonne; to provide terms, conditions, and requirements; and to provide for
5 related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 56:325(B)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8 §325. Daily take, possession, and size limits; freshwater recreational fish; possession
9 of finfish filets prohibited

13 (3) The possession limit for crappie caught in Toledo Bend Reservoir ~~and in~~
14 ~~Lake D'Arbonne~~ on a recreational license shall be one hundred fish.

DIGEST

Walsworth (SB 369)

Present law sets a 50 fish possession limit for crappie on state waters and also provides a 100 fish possession limit for crappie on Lake D'Arbonne.

Proposed law changes the limit from 100 to 50 on Lake D'Arbonne.

Effective August 1, 2014.

(Amends R.S. 56:325(B)(3))

1. Restores current law that prohibits the La. Wildlife and Fisheries Commission from amending the crappie limit on Lake D'Arbonne.
