3	to contain the amount of compensation paid to each individual, corporation, firm,
4	partnership, association, or other legal entity in exchange for furnishing professional
5	services to each holder of a license as defined in R.S. $27:44(14)$ and $353(5)$, and the
6	casino gaming operator.
7	G. The board may impose sanctions on the holder of a license as defined in
8	R.S. 27:44(14) and $353(5)$, or the casino gaming operator for failure to submit to the
9	board the report required by the provisions of this Section.

<u>Present law</u> requires the holder of a riverboat license and the holder of a license for slot machines at racetracks to submit certain information to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board.

<u>Proposed law</u> corrects the cross reference to the statute identifying the license holder authorized for slot machines at racetracks by providing a generic reference to the definition section in that chapter of law and similarly provides a generic reference to the definition section of law for the riverboat gaming chapter of law.

Effective August 1, 2022.
