3	to provide for the burden of proof to introduce evidence; and to provide for related
4	matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Code of Evidence Article 804(B)(7) is hereby amended and reenacted to
7	read as follows:
8	Art. 804. Hearsay exceptions; declarant unavailable
9	* * *
10	B. Hearsay exceptions. The following are not excluded by the hearsay rule
11	if the declarant is unavailable as a witness:
12	* * *
13	(7) (a) Forfeiture by wrongdoing. A statement offered against a party that
14	has engaged or acquiesced in wrongdoing that was intended to, and did, procure the
15	unavailability of the declarant as a witness.
16	(b) A party seeking to introduce statements under the forfeiture by
17	wrongdoing hearsay exception shall establish, by a preponderance of the
18	evidence, that the party against whom the statement is offered, engaged or
19	acquiesced in the wrongdoing.
