INSURANCE COMMISSIONER. Requires the insurance commissioner's designee to the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Corporation board of directors receive compensation only if his designee is not a state employee. (8/1/22)

2	To enact R.S. 23:1398(F)(3), relative to the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Corporation;
3	to provide compensation for the insurance commissioner's designee to the board of
4	directors for the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Corporation; to provide terms
5	and conditions; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 23:1398(F)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1398. Board of directors

11	(3) The commissioner of insurance may appoint a designee to serve as a
12	member of the board and the designee shall be entitled to receive board fees
13	commensurate with industry standards, for actual attendance at board meetings
14	and for vouchered expenses incurred while fulfilling the official duties only if
15	this designee is not a state employee.

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Talbot

<u>Present law</u> provides an exception to receiving a salary for legislative members and the commissioner of insurance but requires other board members to receive board fees commensurate with industry standards for attending board meetings and to pay for expenses while fulfilling their official duties.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but authorizes the commissioner of insurance to appoint a person to the board to serve as his designee on the board. Provides that this designee receive board fees commensurate with industry standards for attending board meetings and to pay for expenses while fulfilling his official duties only if his designee is not a state employee.

Effective on August 1, 2022.
