2	To amend and reenact R.S. 13:5304(B)(10) and (K), relative to drug courts; to provide
3	relative to eligibility for a drug division probation program; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 13:5304(B)(10) and (K) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
7	as follows:
8	§5304. The drug division probation program
9	* * *
10	B. Participation in probation programs shall be subject to the following
11	provisions:
12	* * *
13	(10) In order to be eligible for the drug division probation program, the
14	defendant must satisfy each of the following criteria:
15	(a) The defendant cannot have any prior felony convictions conviction for
16	any offenses of effense defined as crimes of violence in R.S. 14:2(B) as a homicide in
17	<u>R.S. 14:29</u> .
18	(b) The crime before the court cannot be a crime of violence as defined in
19	R.S. 14:2(B), including domestic violence or an offense of domestic abuse battery
20	which is punishable by imprisonment at hard labor as provided in R.S. 14:35.3.

1 (c) Other criminal proceedings alleging commission of a crime of violence 2 as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) cannot be pending against the defendant. 3 (d) Repealed by Acts 2013, No. 389, §5. 4 (e)(d) The crime before the court cannot be a charge of driving under the 5 influence of alcohol or any other drug or drugs that resulted in the death of a person. (f) Repealed by Acts 2013, No. 389, §5. 6 7 K. Each drug division shall develop a method of evaluation so that its 8 9 effectiveness can be measured.
