2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:4545.4(E), relative to the board of directors of the Louisiana
3	Energy and Power Authority; to provide relative to the increase of the membership
4	of the board of directors; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related
5	matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:4545.4(E) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§4545.4. Board of directors as governing authority of the Authority

10	E. By an ordinance <del>unanimously</del> adopted and approved by <del>all</del> <u>a majority of</u>
11	members of the board of directors, provisions may be made for the appointment of
12	additional directors to increase the membership of the board of directors to include
13	other appointments by any municipality which, on the effective date of this Act, is
14	engaged in the generation, transmission, or distribution of electricity. The initial term
15	of the new director shall be set forth in said ordinance but shall not exceed five years.
16	Any such municipality desiring representation on the board of directors shall request
17	it by furnishing to the board of directors a resolution duly adopted by its governing

1 authority requesting such representation and furnishing such other contracts, 2 agreements, or information as may be reasonably required by the board of directors. 3 The board of directors shall act upon such request within sixty days and if the request 4 is not granted within said period of sixty days, it shall be considered as denied, and 5 thereafter other requests may be subsequently furnished and considered. 6 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 7 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 11 effective on the day following such approval.

Present law provides for the creation of the Louisiana Energy and Power Authority.

<u>Present law</u> provides that by an ordinance unanimously adopted and approved by all members of the board of directors, provisions may be made for the appointment of additional directors to increase the membership of the board of directors of the Louisiana Energy and Power Authority to include other appointments by any municipality which is engaged in the generation, transmission, or distribution of electricity.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that an ordinance to increase the membership of the board of directors of the Louisiana Energy and Power Authority must be adopted and approved by a majority of members of the board of directors.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
