2	To enact R.S. 48:36, relative to the Department of Transportation and Development; to
3	provide for topographic mapping responsibilities; to authorize the department to
4	develop and maintain a statewide digital geospatial database; to provide for the
5	adoption of rules; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 48:36 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§36. Topographic mapping
9	The department may develop and maintain a statewide digital geospatial
10	database. The department shall act as authority for geographic names, set
11	standards for the mapping of topographic features, and plan and manage data
12	collection for incorporation into a statewide database. Rules and regulations
13	shall be promulgated by the department in accordance with the Administrative
14	Procedure Act as are necessary for the planning and managing of the geospatial
15	<u>data.</u>
16	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
17	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
18	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
19	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
20	effective on the day following such approval.
