2	To amend and reenact the introductory paragraph of R.S. 22:347(A)(4)(a) and the
3	introductory paragraph of R.S. 48:756(A)(1), relative to population estimates used
4	in certain fund distributions; to provide for an entity under the latest federal-state
5	cooperative program for local population estimates; to provide for an effective date;
6	and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 22:347(A)(4)(a) is hereby amended
9	and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§347. Disposition of tax money
11	A. Monies collected under R.S. 22:342 through 349, after being first credited
12	to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund in accordance with Article VII, Section
13	9(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana, shall be credited to a special fund hereby
14	established in the state treasury and known as the "Two Percent Fire Insurance Fund"
15	hereinafter the "fund". Monies in the fund shall be available in amounts appropriated
16	annually by the legislature for the following purposes in the following order of
17	priority:

19	(4) For distribution to each parish governing authority in accordance with
20	rules and regulations established by the state treasurer based upon the formula
21	provided for herein:
22	(a) Except in Orleans Parish, the state treasurer shall pay over to the treasurer
23	of each governing authority of the parish described in R.S. 22:343 the full amount
24	of money due as determined by the state treasurer. These funds shall be allocated,

2	population category of each parish as shown by the latest federal census or as
3	determined by the Division of Business and Economic Research of Louisiana Tech
