6	Section 1. R.S. 49:214.5.1(B)(13), (14) and (15) are hereby amended and reenacted
7	and R.S. 49:214.5.1(16) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

(15) The lieutenant governor, or his designee.
(16) Any member of the board who represents a political subdivision shall
recuse himself from deliberations and from voting on any matter concerning the
taking of action against that political subdivision for lack of compliance with the
plan.
* * *
Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the membership of the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the Lieutenant Governor, or his designee, as a member of the board. Further provides that the speaker of the House and president of the Senate shall be authorized to vote and be counted for purposes of a quorum.

Proposed law makes technical changes to present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
