AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 49:155.7, relative to state symbols; to designate the Cajun waltz as an official
3	state dance; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 49:155.7 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§155.7. State dance
7	There shall be an official state dance. The official state dance shall be the
8	<u>Cajun waltz.</u>
9	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
10	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
11	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
12	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
13	effective on the day following such approval.
