WATER/WATERWAYS. Requires the Sabine River Authority to obtain legislative committee and certain local government approval for out-of-state water sales. (8/1/12)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 38:2325(A)(16), relative to the Sabine River Authority; to
3	provide for the powers and duties of the authority; to provide rules, conditions, and
4	requirement for the sale, utilization, distribution, or consumption of water outside the
5	state; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 38:2325(A)(16) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§2325. Powers
9	A. Said authority shall have the power:

11	(16)(a) To enter into any and all contracts and other agreements with any
12	person, real or artificial, any public or private entity, any government or
13	governmental agency, including the United States of America, the state of Texas, the
14	Sabine River Authority of Texas, the state of Louisiana, and the agencies, bureaus,
15	departments, and political subdivisions thereof, which contracts and other
16	agreements may provide for the sale, conservation, storage, utilization, preservation,
17	distribution, or consumption, whether within or without the state of Louisiana, of the

13	(d) The written concurrence, by resolution and two-thirds vote, of the
14	local governing authority of each parish in the territory of the Sabine River
15	Authority shall be required for any contracts and other agreements which
16	provide for the sale, utilization, distribution, or consumption, outside of the
17	boundaries of the state of Louisiana, of the waters over which the authority has
18	jurisdiction or control. In addition, at least two-thirds of all the local governing
19	authorities in the territory of the Sabine River Authority shall concur before the
20	authority can enter into any such contract or other agreements.

DIGEST

Long (SB 436)

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the Sabine River Authority to enter into contracts which provide for the sale, utilization, distribution, or consumption of water outside the boundaries of the state and requires the written consent of the governor for such contracts.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but also requires the written concurrence by the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment for any contracts and other agreements which provide for the sale, utilization, distribution, or consumption, outside of the boundaries of the state of Louisiana, of the

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waters over which the Sabine River Authority has jurisdiction or control.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires the written concurrence by two-thirds vote of the local governing authority of each parish in the territory of the authority and the concurrence of at least two-thirds of all the local governing authorities in the territory of the Sabine River Authority for any contracts and other agreements which provide for the sale, utilization, distribution, or consumption, outside of the boundaries of the state of Louisiana.

Effective August 1, 2012.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Natural Resources to</u> <u>the original bill</u>

- 1. Requires the authority to receive approval by the legislative committees on natural resources for certain water sales.
- 2. Makes technical changes.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Requires written concurrence by two-thirds vote of the local governing authority of each parish in the territory of the authority and the concurrence of at least two-thirds of all the local governing authorities in the territory of the Sabine River Authority for water sales outside the boundaries of the state in addition to the approval by certain legislative committees.
