MENTAL HEALTH. Prohibits a community-based physical health care provider from discriminating in its offering and providing services to a person based on the person's serious mental illness. (8/1/12)

2	To enact R.S. 40:2013.7, relative to mental health; to provide a prohibition on discrimination
3	by a community-based physical health care provider based on a serious mental
4	illness; to provide definitions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:2013.7 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	<u>§ 2013.7. Prohibition on discrimination by a community-based physical health</u>
8	care provider based on a serious mental illness
9	A. No community-based physical health care provider shall discriminate
10	in the offering or the providing of its services to any person based on the
11	person's serious mental illness.
12	B. For the purposes of this Section, the following terms shall mean:
13	(1) "Community-based physical health care provider" means any facility
14	or institution, whether public or private, that offers diagnosis, treatment, and
15	inpatient or ambulatory care of two or more unrelated persons.
16	(2) Serious mental illness means any of various conditions characterized
17	by impairment of an individual's normal emotional or behavioral functioning.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides exemptions for hospitals, chiropractors, nursing homes, optometrists, or dentists.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to</u> <u>the original bill.</u>

- 1. Replaces healthcare facility with community-based physical health care provider and defines community-based physical health care provider.
- 2. Replaces mental illness or disorder with serious mental illness and defines serious mental illness.
- 3. Provides exemptions for hospitals, chiropractors, nursing homes, optometrists, or dentists.
