DIGEST

Walsworth (SB 452)

<u>Present law</u> provides that certain records or information contained therein which are held by law enforcement agencies and communication districts will not be subject to disclosure.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if requested pursuant to <u>present law</u> the booking photograph of any person arrested for an alleged offense will be disclosed.

Effective August 1, 2012.
