21	necessity of advertising for and receiving bids.

All contracts of leases of school lands, including but not limited to school

indemnity lands and sixteenth section lands, by a school board within a parish
with a population of not less than forty-two thousand nor more than forty-five
thousand persons according to the latest federal decennial census that were
entered into prior to January 4, 2012, for a term of not more than five years, are
hereby ratified and confirmed and shall have the same force and effect as if the
contracts of lease had been made and executed pursuant to the provisions of
Part I of Chapter 10 of Title 41 of the Louisiana Revised Statues of 1950,

the fair market value for the leases.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
