1 AN ACT

- To repeal R.S. 15:308(C) and 574.22, relative to the Louisiana Risk Review Panel; to repeal
- 3 the statutory authority for the panel; and to provide for related matters.
- 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
- 5 Section 1. R.S. 15:308(C) and 574.22 are hereby repealed.

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> provides for the risk review panel within DPS&C. Further provides for the composition and duties of the panel.

<u>Present law</u> requires the risk review panel to evaluate the risk of danger to society posed by each person convicted of a crime who is confined in a prison facility if released from confinement.

<u>Present law</u> excludes the following persons from this evaluation by the panel:

- 1. A person convicted of a crime of violence.
- 2. A person convicted of a sex offense when the victim is under the age of 18 at the time of commission of the offense.
- 3. Certain controlled dangerous substance violations.

4. A person sentenced as a habitual offender where one or more of the crimes for which the person was convicted is a crime of violence.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective August 1, 2012.
