| 12 | in excess of four hundred sixty-five thousand persons, as determined by the most |
| 13 | recent federal decennial census, of Orleans, then there shall be no fee paid to the |
| 14 | sheriff; however, the "Notice of Repossession" shall still be filed with the sheriff. |
