1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 17:1968.1 and to repeal R.S. 17:1969, relative to funding for the Louisiana
3	School for Math, Science, and the Arts; to provide for the inclusion of the school in
4	the minimum foundation program formula; to provide for the allocation of minimum
5	foundation program funds attributable to such inclusion; to provide relative to
6	appropriations from the state general fund; to provide relative to the annual budget
7	of the Louisiana School for Math, Science, and the Arts; and to provide for related
8	matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 17:1968.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§1968.1. Funding; inclusion in the minimum foundation program formula;
12	other appropriated state funds
13	A.(1)The board of directors of the Louisiana School for Math, Science,
14	and the Arts annually shall prepare and adopt a recommended formula to
15	adequately fund the educational programs at the school. The formula shall
16	have as its goal to provide state funding for the school which shall not be less
17	than the average funding on a per student basis at peer institutions in other
18	states having similar programs and enrollments and may provide for achieving
19	its goal over a multi-year period. The recommended formula shall be submitted
20	to the division of administration as the total budget request for the school.
21	(2) Funding for the school shall be provided through appropriations
22	made directly to the school from the state general fund and through funds
23	appropriated for the minimum foundation program and allocated to the school
24	by the Department of Education.

## **ENROLLED**

1	<b>B.(1)</b> For the purposes of this Section, the Louisiana School for Math,
2	Science, and the Arts shall be considered a public secondary school and, as such,
3	shall be included by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
4	in the formula required by Article VIII, Section 13 of the Constitution of
5	Louisiana used to determine the cost of a minimum foundation program of
6	education in all public elementary and secondary schools.
7	(2) Minimum foundation program funds allocated to the school shall be
8	based upon the school's enrollment, which shall be determined in the same
9	manner as for other public schools, and each student shall be funded at one
10	hundred percent of the state per pupil amount as contained in the minimum
11	foundation program budget letter approved by the State Board of Elementary
12	and Secondary Education.
13	<b><u>C.</u></b> The amount of funding for any budget request submitted as provided
14	in this Section that is not provided through the minimum foundation program
15	formula shall be determined by the legislature.
16	Section 2. R.S. 17:1969 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
17	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
18	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
19	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
20	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
21	effective on the day following such approval.
