SCHOOLS. Provides relative to school employee participation in student-initiated prayer. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:2115.11(B), relative to student-initiated prayer; to provide
3	relative to school employee participation in student-initiated prayer; to provide for
4	conditions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:2115.11(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§2115.11. Prayer; student-initiated; conditions
8	A. * * *
9	B.(1) Any school employee may attend and participate in the gathering if it
10	occurs before the employee's work day begins or after the employee's work day ends.
11	(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection,
12	a school employee may, upon request of a student or students, attend and
13	participate in the gathering during the employee's work day, provided that:
14	(a) The parent or legal guardian of each student in attendance at the
15	gathering has submitted a signed request to the school principal that the
16	employee participate in the gathering.
17	(b) Attendance and participation in the gathering does not interfere with

1 the employee's work duties and, if the employee is a faculty member, such 2 participation shall not interfere with the employee's instructional duties. 3

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Present law (R.S. 17:2115.3) provides that no law, rule, or policy may deny any student attending a public elementary or secondary school the right to participate in voluntary, student-initiated, student-led prayer.

Present law (R.S. 17:2115.11) provides conditions for student-initiated prayer and allows school employees to volunteer to supervise student-initiated prayer. Also provides that any school employee may participate in the gathering if it occurs before the employee's work day begins or after the employee's work day ends.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows a school employee, upon request of a student or students, to participate in a gathering where there is student-initiated prayer during the employee's work day, provided that such participation does not interfere with the employee's assigned work duties. Further provides that if the employee is a faculty member, such participation shall not interfere with the employee's instructional duties.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
