3	firearms; to allow the possession of firearms on certain state lands; to provide terms

5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 56:109(C) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 56:1691 is
7	hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§109. Wildlife management areas; wildlife refuges; public hunting grounds and
9	recreation areas; notice; signs; disabled hunters
10	* * *
11	C. No person shall knowingly take, attempt to take, disturb, or destroy any
12	wild bird or wild quadruped or the nest, egg, or young thereof on lands set apart as
13	wildlife management areas and wildlife refuges, or have in his possession or keep,
14	while on the lands, any firearm, trap, snare, or other device capable of being used in
15	the taking or disturbance of the birds or quadrupeds on such areas, unless the person
16	previously has been expressly authorized by a permit from the department to do so
17	and only for the purpose and under the conditions specified in the permit.

1	<u>A person who lawfully possesses a firearm may possess or transport such</u>
2	firearm within the boundaries of a state park, state historic site, state
3	preservation area, wildlife management area, or wildlife refuge.
