DIGEST

Mills (SB 551)

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 22:1547(C)(3)) requires each licensed insurance producer to comply with continuing education requirements to be eligible for license renewal.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> exempts any person who is a member of the legislature, while that person is serving a term in the legislature, from continuing education requirements for renewal of a license.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the legislator exemption.

Effective January 1, 2013.
