6	the adoption of rules; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:158(I) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§158. School buses for transportation of students; employment of bus operators;
10	alternative means of transportation; improvement of school bus
11	turnarounds

13	I. (1) Each city, parish, and other local public school board may provide
14	transportation to any full-time student who is twenty years of age or younger
15	and attending a technical college campus, that is part of the Louisiana
16	Community and Technical College System, within the jurisdictional boundaries
17	of the local board. If the closest technical college campus is located outside the
18	jurisdictional boundaries of the local school board, the board may facilitate the
19	transportation or coordinate with neighboring boards to facilitate
20	transportation to the technical college campus.
21	(2) The local public school board where the student resides, may assess
22	a fee to each student utilizing the transportation services provided pursuant to
23	this Subsection, not to exceed the actual cost of providing such transportation,
24	including administrative costs.
25	(3) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall adopt
26	rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement
27	provisions of this Subsection.

1	(4) The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to:
2	(a) Local public school boards in a parish with a population of more
3	than three hundred thousand persons according to the most recent federal
4	decennial census.
5	(b) Local public school boards in any parish that operates a parish-wide
6	public transit system that provides sufficient service to meet the transportation
7	needs of students attending technical colleges located in the parish.
