1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 39:51(D) and 1305(C)(2)(a) and to enact R.S. 39:51(B) and (F),
3	relative to government budgets; to provide relative to the content and form of the
4	general appropriations, ancillary, legislative and judicial appropriation bills; to
5	provide for the designation of reductions in any appropriation bill; to provide relative
6	to the content and form of budgets of political subdivisions; to provide for an
7	effective date; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 39:51(D) and 1305(C)(2)(a) are hereby amended and reenacted and
10	R.S. 39:51(B) and (F) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§51. General Appropriation Bill; other appropriation bills
12	* * *
13	B. Repealed by Acts 2003, No. 1029, §1 The General Appropriation Bill
14	and the bill appropriating funds for ancillary expenses of state government shall
15	include for each program, department and budget unit, comparative statements
16	of the number of authorized positions and of the existing operating budget for
17	a date certain to be established by the budget office for the current fiscal year
18	and the appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year.

20	D. The bill appropriating funds for the expenses of the legislature and the bill
21	appropriating funds for the expenses of the judiciary shall be submitted by the
22	legislature and the judiciary, respectively, for introduction no later than forty-five
23	days prior to each regular session of the legislature, except that during the first year
24	of each term they shall be submitted no later than thirty days prior to the regular
25	session of the legislature. The bill appropriating funds for the expenses of the

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1	legislature and the bill appropriating funds for the expenses of the judiciary
2	shall include a comparative statement of the existing operating budget for the
3	current fiscal year and the appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year.

5	F. Any appropriation bill in which a reduction in an appropriation is
6	authorized shall designate the reduction by placing parenthesis around the
7	amount.

11	C. The budget document setting forth the proposed financial plan for the
12	general fund and each special revenue fund shall include the following:
13	* * *
14	(2)(a) A statement for the general fund and each special revenue fund
15	showing the estimated fund balances at the beginning of the year; estimates of all
16	receipts and revenues to be received; revenues itemized by source; recommended
17	expenditures itemized by agency, department, function, and character; other
18	financing sources and uses by source and use; and the estimated fund balance at the
19	end of the fiscal year. Such statements shall also include a clearly presented
20	side-by-side detailed comparison of such information for the current year,
21	including the fund balances at the beginning of the year, year-to-date actual
22	receipts and revenues received and estimates of all receipts and revenues to be
23	received the remainder of the year; estimated and actual revenues itemized by
24	source; year-to-date actual expenditures and estimates of all expenditures to be
25	made the remainder of the year itemized by agency, department, function, and
26	character; other financing sources and uses by source and use, both year-to-
27	date actual and estimates for the remainder of the year; the year-to-date actual
28	and estimated fund balances as of the end of the fiscal year; and the percentage
29	change for each item of information.

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1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2011; if vetoed by the
2	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
3	January 1, 2011, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
