CLERKS OF COURT. Provides for automobile expense allowance for the clerk of court of Allen Parish. (8/1/14)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:783(D)(7), relative to clerks of court; to provide for an
3 automobile expense allowance for the clerk of court of Allen Parish; and to provide
4 for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 13:783(D)(7) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §783. Expenses of clerk's office

11 (7) In **Allen Parish**, Acadia Parish, Bienville Parish, Bossier Parish, Caddo
12 Parish, Cameron Parish, Claiborne Parish, DeSoto Parish, East Feliciana Parish,
13 Franklin Parish, Iberia Parish, Lincoln Parish, Morehouse Parish, Natchitoches
14 Parish, Ouachita Parish, Red River Parish, St. Charles Parish, St. Helena Parish, St.
15 Landry Parish, St. Tammany Parish, Tangipahoa Parish, Vermilion Parish,
16 Washington Parish, Webster Parish, West Baton Rouge Parish, and West Feliciana
17 Parish, the clerks of the district courts of those parishes may receive an automobile

1 expense allowance equal to fifteen percent of their annual salary provided the clerk
 2 of court maintains three hundred thousand dollars of automobile insurance per
 3 accident for bodily injury and one hundred thousand dollars of automobile insurance
 4 per accident for property damage. The expense allowance shall come from surplus
 5 funds in each of the offices of the clerks of court and at no additional expense to the
 6 state or local governing authority.

DIGEST

LaFleur (SB 67)

Present law provides that in Acadia Parish, Cameron Parish, East Feliciana Parish, Iberia Parish, Red River Parish, St. Tammany Parish, Tangipahoa Parish, Washington Parish, and West Feliciana Parish, the clerks of the district courts of those parishes may receive an automobile expense allowance equal to 15% of their annual salary, provided that the clerk of court maintains \$300,000 of automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and \$100,000 of automobile insurance per accident for property damage.

Present law further provides that the expense allowance is to come from surplus funds in each of the offices of the clerks of court and at no additional expense to the state or local governing authority.

Proposed law retains present law and adds the Allen Parish clerk of court, to the list of clerks of court who are allowed to receive an automobile expense allowance.

Effective August 1, 2014.
