12	D. Should the employee fail to make the required contributions within four
13	years, or a time period authorized in accordance with Subsection E of this
14	Section, service in the uniformed services credit shall be used only count toward for
15	determining eligibility for retirement benefits. Any unpaid actuarial cost to the
16	retirement system shall be borne by the employers through reflection in the employer
17	contribution rate established by the Public Retirement Systems Actuarial
18	Committee pursuant to R.S. 11:102 or 103, or as provided by the actuarial
19	funding requirements and any other laws, rules, or regulations applicable to the
20	public retirement system in which the employee receives credit under the
21	provisions of this Subpart.
22	E. Notwithstanding Subsection D of this Section, if any employee fails
23	to make the required contributions within four years of his reemployment, the
24	retirement system, pension fund, or employee benefit plan may permit such

1	employee to make such contributions within the time period allowable under the
2	Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act of 1994
3	(USERRA).
4	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2010; if vetoed by the
5	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
6	June 30, 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
