2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:103(A)(7) and (8) and (B)(2), and to enact R.S. 14:103(C),
3	relative to the crime of disturbing the peace; to provide relative to disturbing the
4	peace at funerals; to provide for definitions; to provide for penalties; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 14:103(A)(7) and (8) and (B)(2) are hereby amended and reenacted,
8	and R.S. 14:103(C) is hereby enacted, to read as follows:
9	\$103. Disturbing the peace
10	A. Disturbing the peace is the doing of any of the following in such manner
11	as would foreseeably disturb or alarm the public:
12	* * *
13	(7) Intentionally engaging in any act or any utterance, gesture, or display
14	designed to disrupt a funeral, funeral route, funeral home viewing, funeral
15	procession, wake, memorial service, or burial of a deceased person during the
16	period beginning one hundred twenty minutes before and ending one hundred
17	twenty minutes after the funeral or burial, within three hundred feet of the
18	funeral or burial.
19	(8)(a) Intentionally blocking, impeding, inhibiting, or in any other manner
20	obstructing or interfering with a funeral route.
21	(b) Intentionally blocking, impeding, inhibiting, or in any other manner
22	obstructing or interfering, within five hundred feet, with access into or from any

1	building or parking lot of a building in which a funeral, wake, memorial service, or
2	burial is being conducted, or any burial plot or the parking lot of the cemetery in
3	which a funeral, wake, memorial service, or burial is being conducted, during the
4	period beginning one hundred twenty minutes before and ending one hundred
5	twenty minutes after the funeral or burial.
6	B.(1) * * *
7	(2) Whoever commits the crime of disturbing the peace as provided for in
8	Paragraphs (A)(7) and (8) of this Section shall be fined not more than one five
9	hundred dollars or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.
10	C. Definitions. For purposes of Paragraphs (A)(7) and (8) of this
11	Section:
12	(1) "Funeral" includes a funeral, funeral home viewing, wake, or
13	memorial service.
14	(2) "Funeral route" means the route of ingress or egress from the
15	location of a funeral or burial, including thirty feet from the outer edge of the
16	outside lane of the route.
17	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
18	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
19	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
20	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
21	effective on the day following such approval.
