1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:578.2(A), (B), (C), and (D) and to enact R.S. 56:578.2(F),
3	relative to the Louisiana Seafood Promotion and Marketing Board; to provide for its
4	membership; to provide for the election of its officers; to provide for certain term
5	limits for officers; to provide certain requirements, terms, and conditions; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 56:578.2(A), (B), (C), and (D) are hereby amended and reenacted
9	and R.S. 56:578.2(F) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§578.2. Louisiana Seafood Promotion and Marketing Board; creation and
11	organization
12	A.(1) There is hereby created in the office of fisheries of the Department of
13	Wildlife and Fisheries the Louisiana Seafood Promotion and Marketing Board. The
14	agency shall have its domicile in Baton Rouge and shall be governed by a board of
15	trustees composed of sixteen fourteen members, fifteen thirteen members to be
16	appointed by the governor from persons engaged in the commercial seafood,
17	crawfish and alligator industry in Louisiana to serve terms concurrent with the
18	governor, and the sixteenth fourteenth member to be the secretary of the
19	Department of Wildlife and Fisheries or his designated representative, who shall
20	serve as an ex officio <u>nonvoting</u> member.
21	(2) The appointed members shall be chosen as follows:
22	(a) One shall be appointed from a list of three names submitted by members
23	from Louisiana of the American Shrimp Processors Association and the Louisiana
24	Shrimp Association.
25	(b) One shall be appointed from a list of three names submitted by the
26	Louisiana Oyster Dealers and Growers Association.
27	(c) One shall be appointed from a list of three names submitted by the
28	Louisiana crawfish industry. The appointment shall rotate between a farmer, a

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1	harvester, and a processor.
2	(d) One shall be appointed from a list of three names submitted by the
3	Louisiana Restaurant Association Oyster Task Force.
4	(e) Two One shall represent the harvesting sector of the shrimp industry, one
5	or more of which shall be appointed from a list of <u>three</u> names submitted by shrimp
6	organizations or associations currently active throughout the state the Louisiana
7	Retailers Association and shall be a seafood buyer .
8	(3) Of the remaining nine <u>eight</u> members to be appointed:
9	(a) One member shall be a seafood retailer or wholesaler appointed from a
10	list of three names submitted by the Louisiana Shrimp Association.
11	(b) One member shall represent the commercial saltwater finfish industry.
12	The appointment shall rotate between a harvester and a processor.
13	(c) One member shall represent the commercial freshwater finfish industry.
14	be appointed from a list of three names submitted by the Louisiana Restaurant
15	Association.
16	(d) One member shall be a seafood processor.
17	(e) One member shall represent the crab industry be appointed from a list
18	of three names submitted by the Crab Task Force.
19	(f) One member shall be a home economist.
20	(g)(f) One member shall represent the wild catfish industry. <u>The</u>
21	appointment shall rotate between a farmer, a harvester, and a processor.
22	(h)(g) One member shall be a marketing specialist.
23	(i)(h) One member shall represent the alligator industry. The appointment
24	shall rotate between a farmer, a harvester, and a processor.
25	(4) The names of each of the fifteen <u>thirteen</u> members appointed by the
26	governor shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation.
27	B. The members of the board shall meet and elect a chairman, vice chairman,
28	and a secretary-treasurer from the membership of the board At its first regular
29	meeting in the third quarter of each state fiscal year, the board shall elect for
30	<u>a one year term a chairman and vice chairman, who shall also be the chairman-</u>

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1	elect, and a secretary-treasurer, whose duties shall be those customarily exercised
2	by such officers or specifically designated by the board. No member shall be
3	elected as an officer until such member has served at least one year on the
4	board. No member elected chairman shall serve consecutive terms and no
5	member may serve as chairman more than two terms. No chairman shall serve
6	as vice chairman in the term following his term as chairman. The board may
7	establish rules and regulations for its own government and the administration of the
8	affairs of the board. The board may disqualify any appointed member for cause,
9	including excessive absences from board meetings. If any board member is so
10	disqualified, the vacancy created thereby shall be filled by appointment by the
11	governor for the remainder of the unexpired term. A vacancy occurring on the
12	board for any reason shall be filled in the same manner as the original
13	appointment was made. However, members appointed to fill the vacancies shall
14	only serve for the unexpired term of their predecessors.
15	C. The presence of nine eight members of the board shall constitute a quorum
16	for the transaction of all business and the carrying out of duties of the board. Each
17

7	F.(1) The terms of all members serving on the board shall expire at
8	midnight on December 31, 2012. Appointments for terms beginning on January
9	1, 2013, shall be made as follows:
10	(a) The terms of the members appointed pursuant to Subparagraphs
11	(A)(2)(a) and (b), and (A)(3)(b) and (h) of this Section shall be for three years.
12	(b) The terms of the members appointed pursuant to Subparagraphs
13	(A)(2)(c), (A)(3)(e),(f), and (g) of this Section shall be for one year.
14	(c) The term of the members appointed pursuant to Subparagraphs
15	(A)(2)(d) and (e) and (A)(3)(a),(c), and (d) of this Section shall be for two years.
16	(2) At the end of each term set forth in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection,
17	the members appointed thereafter shall serve a term of four years.
18	(3) At the first regularly scheduled meeting of the board after January
19	1, 2013, the board shall adopt rules and bylaws which shall be submitted no
20	later than thirty days after their adoption to the House Natural Resources and
21	Environment Committee and the Senate Committee on Natural Resources for
22	approval by the committees. The rules and bylaws shall not go into effect until
23	the committees approve of such rules and bylaws.
