1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 14:20.1, relative to self-defense; to require full investigation of all deaths due
3	to violence or suspicious circumstances when a claim of self-defense is raised; and
4	to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 14:20.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§20.1. Investigation of death due to violence or suspicious circumstances when
8	claim of self-defense is raised
9	Whenever a death results from violence or under suspicious
10	circumstances and a claim of self-defense is raised, the appropriate law
11	enforcement agency and coroner shall expeditiously conduct a full investigation
12	of the death. All evidence of such investigation shall be preserved.
13	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
14	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
15	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
16	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
17	effective on the day following such approval.
