SCHOOLS. Provides relative to the composition of charter school boards in certain parishes. (gov sig)

AN ACT 1 2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:3991(A)(1)(c)(iii), and to enact R.S. 17:3991(A)(1)(c)(iv), relative to the membership of a charter school governing or management board; to 3 provide relative to the composition of such board; and to provide for related matters. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 17:3991(A)(1)(c)(iii) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 6 7 17:3991(A)(1)(c)(iv) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 8 §3991. Charter schools; requirements; limitations; renewal; amendment; revocation; 9 board membership 10 A.(1)(a)11 (c)(i) (iii) Each charter school shall be in full compliance with the provisions of this 12 13 Subparagraph by not later than January 1, 2004. Beginning October 1, 2018, the membership of the governing or management board of each charter school 14 located in a parish with a population of between three hundred twenty-five 15 thousand and three hundred seventy-five thousand persons, based on the most 16 recent federal decennial census, shall include at least one member who is a 17

1 parent, legal guardian, or grandparent of a student enrolled in the charter 2 school, or an alumni of the school, who may be appointed or elected. Each 3 charter school governing or management board shall adopt a policy prescribing the process and timelines for either appointing or electing a parent, legal 4 guardian, or grandparent of a student, or an alumni of the school to the board. 5 The policy shall be provided to the parents of each child enrolled in the school 6 7 and published on the school's website. 8 (iv) Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, the governing or 9 management board of each charter school, other than a Type 2 charter school, 10 located in a parish with a population of between three hundred twenty-five 11 thousand and three hundred seventy-five thousand persons, based on the most recent federal decennial census, shall be representative of the community in 12 13 which the charter school is located and no fewer than sixty percent of its members shall reside in the parish in which the school is located. 14 15 16 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 17 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 18 19 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 20 effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that beginning October 1, 2018, each charter school governing or management board located in a parish with a population between 325,000 and 375,000 persons shall include at least one member who is a parent, legal guardian, or grandparent of a student enrolled in the charter school, or an alumni of the school, who may be elected or appointed.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each board to adopt a policy prescribing the process and timelines for appointing or electing the parent, legal guardian, grandparent, or alumni. Additionally provides that the policy be provided to the parents of each child enrolled in the school and published on the school's website.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, each charter school governing or management board other than a Type 2 charter school, located in a parish with population between 325,000 and 375,000 persons shall be representative of the community in which the charter school is located and no fewer than sixty percent of its members shall reside in the parish in which the school is located.

Proposed law deletes obsolete timeline in present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 17:3991(A)(1)(c)(iii); adds R.S. 17:3991(A)(1)(c)(iv))

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

## <u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill</u>

- 1. Limits effectiveness of the bill to certain parishes.
- 2. Provides that a grandparent or school alumni is eligible to serve on the board.
- 3. Requires board to adopt selection policies and provide policies to school parents and post on the school's website.

## Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Exempts "Type 2 charter school" from the provision of <u>proposed law</u> beginning with the 2019-2020 school year.
