6	in the district; to remove certain restrictions on renewing the fee; and to provide for
7	related matters.

9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 33:9091.1(D)(1)(c), (d), (e), and (f) and (3)(a) and (F)(3)(c)(ii) are
11	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
12	§9091.1. Lakeview Crime Prevention District

14	D. Governance. (1) The district shall be governed by a board of
15	commissioners consisting of eleven members as follows:

17	(c) The member or members of the Louisiana House of Representatives who
18	represent the area which comprises the district shall appoint one member \underline{two}
19	members.
20	(d) The member or members of the Louisiana Senate who represent the area
21	which comprises the district shall appoint one member two members.
22	(e) The assessor for the second municipal district shall appoint one member.
23	(f) The assessor for the seventh municipal district shall appoint one member.
24	(g) The mayor shall appoint one member.
25	(h) (f) The council member or council members who represent the district

Parcel fee. The governing authority of the city of New Orleans is hereby authorized to impose and collect a parcel fee within the district subject to and in 8 9 accordance with the provisions of this Subsection: 10 11 (3) 12 13 (c) 14 (ii) The fee may be renewed as provided in Subparagraph (3)(a) of this 15 Subsection Paragraph at a mayoral primary election an election held for that 16 purpose in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code. subsequent to the 1998 17 mayoral primary election. 18 19 Section 2. R.S. 33:9091.1(D)(1)(g) and (h) are hereby repealed in their entirety. 20 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010; if vetoed by the governor 21 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 22 2010, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
