1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 32:300.1.1, relative to electric low-speed scooters; to provide relative to the
3	operation of an electric low-speed scooter; to provide relative to the definition of an
4	"electric low-speed scooter"; to provide relative to the requirements of an electric
5	low-speed scooter; to exempt an electric low-speed scooter from certain
6	requirements of motor vehicles; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for
7	related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 32:300.1.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§300.1.1. Electric low-speed scooters; operation; exceptions
11	A.(1) Electric low-speed scooters may operate on sidewalks, bicycle
12	paths, and highways, except that the department or any parish or municipal
13	governing authority, or both, may limit or prohibit the operation of such
14	scooters on any sidewalk, bicycle path, or highway under its jurisdiction if such
15	prohibition or regulation is in the interest of safety.
16	(2) A parish or municipal governing authority may reasonably regulate
17	and assess penalties for moving or parking violations applicable to the operator
18	of an electric low-speed scooter on any sidewalk, bicycle path, or highway under
19	its jurisdiction.
20	B. For purposes of this Section, the term "electric low-speed scooter"
21	shall mean a rental or commercial scooter weighing less than one hundred
22	pounds that has handlebars and an electric motor, is solely powered by an
23	electric motor or human power, and has a maximum speed of not more than

1	twenty miles per hour on a paved level surface when powered solely by an
2	electric motor. An electric low-speed scooter shall not be considered a motor-
3	driven cycle, a vehicle, or a motor vehicle.
4	C. No electric low-speed scooter shall be used to carry more persons at
5	one time than the number of persons for whom it is designed and equipped.
6	D. No person operating an electric low-speed scooter shall attach himself
7	or the scooter to any other vehicle being operated upon a highway.
8	E. No person operating an electric low-speed scooter on a roadway shall
9	carry any package, bundle, or article that prevents the operator from keeping
10	at least one hand on its handlebars.
11	F.(1) Every person operating an electric low-speed scooter upon a
12	roadway shall ride as near to the right side of the roadway as practicable,
13	exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle or a vehicle proceeding in
14	the same direction, except under any of the following circumstances:
15	(a) When overtaking and passing another electric low-speed scooter,

1	safe distance until safely past the overtaken electric low-speed scooter. The
2	operator of a motor vehicle may pass an electric low-speed scooter traveling in
3	the same direction in a no-passing zone only when it is safe to do so.
4	(3) Every person operating an electric low-speed scooter upon a highway
5	of this state shall be granted all of the rights and shall be subject to all the duties
6	applicable to the driver of a vehicle by this Chapter, except as provided in this
7	Section or as otherwise limited or prohibited by the department or any parish
8	or municipal governing authority, and except as to those provisions of this
9	Chapter which by their very nature can have no application.
10	G. An electric low-speed scooter shall be equipped with a brake which
11	enables the operator to make its braked wheels skid on dry, level, and clean
12	pavements.
13	H. An electric low-speed scooter, when in use during the times specified
14	in R.S. 32:301, shall be equipped with appropriate lights, reflectors, or reflective
15	markings.
16	I. Any operator of an electric low-speed scooter under the age of
17	seventeen years shall wear an approved helmet as provided in R.S. 32:199.
18	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019.
