2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:2852, relative to judicial agency referral residential facilities;
3	to provide for inspection and certification of judicial agency referral residential
4	facilities; to provide for accreditation; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:2852 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§2852. Facilities providing housing or temporary residence to individuals referred
8	by judicial agencies
9	A. Any facility, including pretrial diversion facilities, not otherwise required
10	to be licensed by the Department of Health and Hospitals or the Department of
11	Social Services, that provides housing or temporary residence for individuals who
12	have been arrested for the commission of a crime and who are referred by any
13	judicial agency, including the District Attorney's office, shall be regulated by rules
14	adopted and enforced by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections for the
15	operation of such facilities.
16	B. The rules shall include, but not be limited to, providing for the
17	construction, standards of operation, and services provided for such facilities. <u>All</u>
18	rules shall be adopted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.
19	C. No facility shall provide housing or temporary residence to any individual
20	and no judicial agency shall refer any individual to a facility providing housing or
21	temporary residence until the Department of Public Safety and Corrections has
22	adopted rules and has inspected the facility and certified that the facility is in
23	compliance with such rules as provided for by this Section.
