SENATE BILL NO. 97

SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Repeals provisions relative to the Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT  
2 To repeal Subpart B-35 of Part IV of Chapter I of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes  
3 of 1950, comprised of R.S. 33:130.701 through 130.709, relative to the Tangipahoa  
4 Parish Economic Development District; to provide for an effective date; and to  
5 provide for related matters.

6 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. Subpart B-35 of Part IV of Chapter I of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised  
9 Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 33:130.701 through 130.709, is hereby repealed in its  
10 entirety.

11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
15 effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

Nevers (SB 97)

Present law creates a political subdivision of the state within the parish of Tangipahoa to be known as the Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District. Provides that the purpose of the district is for the primary object and purpose of promoting and encouraging the development of economic and industrial opportunities, stimulating the economy through renewed commerce and industry, and for the utilization and development of natural and human resources of the area by providing job opportunities.

Proposed law repeals the Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
