A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To declare the month of May as "National Military Appreciation Month" in Louisiana.

WHEREAS, this month affords the nation a time and place on which to focus and draw attention to our many expressions of appreciation and recognition of our armed services through numerous activities and through becoming better acquainted with our rich American history; and

WHEREAS, as the state which is home to the National World War II Museum in

New Orleans, it is especially fitting that Louisiana join in this national time of honor and

tribute to all those heroes who have served in the armed services for their particular

WHEREAS, by declaring the month of May "National Military Appreciation

Month", Americans recognize those on active duty in all branches of the services, Army,

Navy, Marines, Air Force, and Coast Guard, as well as those in the National Guard and

Reserves, and all veterans and all of their families who number over ninety million

Americans during the nearly two hundred forty years of this glorious republic, the United

States of America.
