

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries is charged with the duty to
2 manage, protect, conserve, and replenish the wildlife and fish in the state.

3 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
4 urge and request the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to study entering into recreational
5 fishing and hunting license reciprocity agreements with Arkansas, Mississippi, and Texas,
6 including an evaluation of current hunting and fishing license categories and how they
7 compare with similar license categories with Arkansas, Mississippi, and Texas, and how
8 they may be improved upon to increase the number of visitors who wish to enjoy Louisiana's
9 wildlife.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of the Department of Wildlife and
11 Fisheries shall submit the findings of the study to the House Committee on Natural
12 Resources and Environment and the Senate Committee on Natural Resources no later than
13 January 1, 2013.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
15 secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.
