SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 13

ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Requests parish governing authorities to provide markings or striping on parish roads.

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request parish governing authorities to provide markings or striping on parish
3 roads.

4 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 32:235 provides relative to uniform highway
5 marking systems and requires parish authorities to place and maintain traffic control devices
6 on parish roads in accordance with standards established by the Department of
7 Transportation and Development; and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Development has adopted the
9 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for public highways in Louisiana, including
10 parish roads; and

11 WHEREAS, the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices provides standards for
12 the installation of centerline and edge line pavement markings on public highways, including
13 parish roads; and

14 WHEREAS, the installation of centerline and edge line pavement markings on parish
15 roads enhance safety and have unique value as visual references to guide road users,
16 particularly during adverse weather and visibility conditions.

17 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
18 urge and request the parish governing authorities to install centerline and edge line pavement

1 markings on parish roads in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control
2 Devices.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
4 parish governing authority of each parish in the state of Louisiana.
