SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 13

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request local municipal and parish governing authorities to provide markings

or striping on local municipal and parish roads.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 32:235 provides relative to uniform highway

marking systems and requires local municipal and parish authorities to place and maintain

traffic control devices on local municipal and parish roads in accordance with standards

established by the Department of Transportation and Development; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Development has adopted the

Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for public highways in Louisiana, including

local municipal and parish roads; and

WHEREAS, the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices provides standards for

the installation of centerline and edge line pavement markings on public highways, including

local municipal and parish roads; and

WHEREAS, the installation of centerline and edge line pavement markings on local

municipal and parish roads enhance safety and have unique value as visual references to

guide road users, particularly during adverse weather and visibility conditions.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

urge and request local municipal and parish governing authorities to install centerline and

edge line pavement markings on local municipal and parish roads in accordance with the

Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the

Police Jury Association of Louisiana and the Louisiana Municipal Association and that the

associations are hereby requested to make their members aware of its contents.
