CONGRESS. Memorializes the United States Congress to enact the New Alternative Transportation to Give Americans Solutions Act of 2009.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To memorialize the United States Congress to take necessary actions to promptly consider
3	and pass the New Alternative Transportation to Give Americans Solutions Act of
4	2009 (H.R. 1835 and S. 1408) and to urge each member of the Louisiana
5	congressional delegation to express their support for the Act by becoming a
6	cosponsor.
7	WHEREAS, located in Desoto Parish, Louisiana, the Haynesville Shale is the largest
8	natural gas field in the continental United States; and
9	WHEREAS, the Haynesville Shale holds approximately two hundred and fifty-one
10	trillion cubic feet of recoverable natural gas; and
11	WHEREAS, drilling and recovery technology allows natural gas to be utilized in an
12	environmentally safe and economically viable manner; and
13	WHEREAS, domestic gas is the only resource that can replace imported gasoline and
14	diesel as a transportation fuel; and
15	WHEREAS, Congress is currently considering the New Alternative Transportation
16	to Give Americans Solutions (H.R. 1835 and S. 1408) which provides incentives to move
17	cars and light trucks as well as heavy-duty trucks from imported gasoline or diesel to
18	domestic natural gas and encourages development of engines that reduce emissions, improve
