SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 32

BY SENATOR HEWITT

LOCAL AGENCIES. Suspends legal requirements to ensure the continued operation of local government.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To suspend until sixty days after final adjournment of the 2021 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana all deadlines and quorum requirements of local public bodies of state law to ensure the continued operation of local government.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends the provisions of state law which establish deadlines relative to and quorum requirements of, local public bodies, to ensure the continued operation of local government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment of the 2021 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
