2 To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development study the feasibility
3 of constructing a second bridge across the Red River in Natchitoches Parish.
4 WHEREAS, traffic flow, economic development, and public safety are but a few of
5 the vital issues a second bridge across the Red River would effectively address; and
6 WHEREAS, the Natchitoches Parish Police Jury through a resolution has formally
7 requested the state of Louisiana take the necessary steps in making a second bridge become
8 a reality; and
9 WHEREAS, for Natchitoches Parish to reach its full potential as an economic hub
10 of northwest Louisiana, a study on the feasibility of constructing a second bridge across the
11 Red River in Natchitoches Parish needs to begin at the Department of Transportation and
12 Development.
13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
14 urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development study the feasibility
15 of constructing a second bridge across the Red River in Natchitoches Parish.
16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
17 Department of Transportation and Development and the Natchitoches Parish Police Jury.
