

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 42

BY SENATOR PERRY AND REPRESENTATIVE ORTEGO

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To designate the city of Scott as the Boudin Capital of the World.

WHEREAS, boudin, a delicacy of the Cajun culture, has long been made and sold in the city of Scott; and

WHEREAS, there are numerous business establishments within the city of Scott which sell boudin; and

WHEREAS, five of these business establishments within the city of Scott account for the manufacture and sale of over one million three hundred thousand pounds of boudin per year, and these stores employ approximately eighty-three employees; and

WHEREAS, sales of boudin in the city of Scott amount to approximately five million dollars per year; and

WHEREAS, sales taxes generated from the sale of boudin result in substantial financial income to the city of Scott; and

WHEREAS, the boudin prepared and sold in the city of Scott is the best-tasting boudin in the state of Louisiana and the world; and

WHEREAS, due to the financial and cultural impact of boudin and the sale of boudin on the city and citizens of Scott, the city of Scott is in the process of establishing an annual boudin festival; and

WHEREAS, the city of Scott has long been known to its citizens and tourists as the Boudin Capital of the World.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate the city of Scott as the Boudin Capital of the World.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the mayor of Scott.
