SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 46

COASTAL PROTECT/RES AUTH. Approves the comprehensive master plan for integrated coastal protection.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To approve the comprehensive master plan for integrated coastal protection projects, as
3	adopted by the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority.
4	WHEREAS, R.S. 49:214.5.1 et seq., provides for the creation, duties, and
5	responsibilities of the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (authority); and
6	WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the authority include the development of a
7	state comprehensive master plan for integrated coastal protection, which should address
8	integrated coastal protection efforts from both short-term and long-range perspectives, and
9	incorporate the structural, management, and institutional components of both efforts; and
10	WHEREAS, the comprehensive master plan for integrated coastal protection shall
11	include a list of projects and programs required for the protection, conservation,
12	enhancement and restoration of the coastal area, the action required of each agency to
13	implement said project or program, and a schedule and estimated cost for the
14	implementation of each project or program included in the plan; and
15	WHEREAS, as required under the provisions of R.S. 49:214.5.3, the comprehensive
16	master plan for integrated coastal protection adopted by the authority must be submitted to
17	the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment and the Senate Committee on
18	Natural Resources and the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public

1	Works and the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works; and
2	WHEREAS, the legislature may approve or disapprove of the comprehensive master
3	plan for integrated coastal protection by resolution adopted by a majority vote of the
4	members of each house of the legislature; and
5	WHEREAS, the authority shall implement the comprehensive master plan for
6	integrated coastal protection if the legislature approves such plan, of if the legislature fails
7	to take action on such plan within sixty days after the plan is submitted.
8	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
9	approve the comprehensive master plan for integrated coastal protection, as adopted by the
10	Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express
12	its specific intent that such comprehensive master plan for integrated coastal protection shall
13	include and maintain a secondary level of hurricane protection, and that the Coastal
14	Protection and Restoration Authority and other entities implementing such master plan
15	extend integrated coastal protection to include and protect the greatest number of coastal
16	communities.
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
18	chairman of the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority.
