

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 9

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to study widening and lengthening the on-ramp to Interstate 110 from which traffic traveling from the state capitol enters Interstate 110 north in Baton Rouge.

WHEREAS, the width and length of the on-ramp to Interstate 110 for traffic traveling from the state capitol to travel north on Interstate 110 is dangerous to such traffic entering Interstate 110 north in Baton Rouge.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to study widening and lengthening the on-ramp to Interstate 110 from which traffic traveling from the state capitol enters Interstate 110 north in Baton Rouge, and to report its findings and recommendations to the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works and to the House Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works, not later than sixty days prior to the beginning of the 2013 Regular Session of the Legislature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
