1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend and congratulate Aesha Rashell Magee of Mt. Hermon, Louisiana, on being
3 crowned Miss Black Louisiana USA 2017.

4 WHEREAS, Aesha Rashell Magee is a native of Mt. Hermon and she attended Mt.
5 Hermon School throughout her school years, and she graduated with honors in 2015, was
6 elected Miss MHS by her classmates, and was involved in a variety of clubs and sports; and

8 Marie Brumfield, all of Mt. Hermon, and the late James Brumfield and the late
9 Willie J. Magee; and

17 WHEREAS, in August 2017, Aesha Magee will be traveling to Washington, D.C.,
18 to compete for the title of Miss Black USA 2017; and

1 WHEREAS, the Miss Black USA organization is the premier pageant for women of
2 color and has awarded its participants with substantial scholarships through the years of its
3 existence; and

4 WHEREAS, the goals of the Miss Black USA organization are to empower women
5 to use their voice, own their power, and redefine what it means to be a compassionate,
6 confident, and beautiful black woman in today's society; and

7 WHEREAS, Aesha Rashell Magee takes her role as Miss Black Louisiana 2017 as
8 an honor that comes with certain responsibilities; she is a bright, capable, and giving young
9 woman who takes seriously the role of representing the state of Louisiana in the Miss Black
10 USA 2017 contest and is a young woman of whom Louisianians can be proud as an
