WHEREAS, she was an avid reader, a talented cook, a lover of card games, and she enjoyed spending time with friends and family, always bringing laughter and joy to those around her; and

WHEREAS, Patrice's compassionate heart led her to care for many children in need, treating them as her own and providing them with love, support, and protection; and

WHEREAS, Patrice was a devoted mother and grandmother, ensuring her children, Sparkle, Shinequa "Neek", and Cordero Anderson, were well-known and cherished, along with Deja Malveaux, Harold "Pop" Savoy, and Jontavious Auzenne, whom she loved as her own; and
