Wade, Louisiana agencies have saved thousands of unborn children from abortion, and in recent years, they have helped the annual number of abortions in Louisiana decrease; and

WHEREAS, in addition to saving unborn lives, these agencies have empowered mothers in difficult situations by providing material and emotional support both before and after the birth of their child and by encouraging the parents to place their child for adoption; and

WHEREAS, these life-affirming agencies outnumber abortion facilities in Louisiana by five to one, showing through these agencies that Louisiana is a pro-life state.
