WHEREAS, Ms. Arriola graduated from Warren Easton High School in 2012 and had a partial scholarship offer to attend Loyola University to study criminal justice; and

WHEREAS, Milan was independent and committed to her own goals and she chose the career path rather than college after high school graduation, working numerous jobs to support herself and live on her own in an apartment; and

WHEREAS, while at Warren Easton High School, Milan was captain of the majorette team and she skillfully led her majorettes with a genuine smile, exhibiting a strong work ethic, and obvious enjoyment of life, always looking for the good in everyone and every experience; and

WHEREAS, Milan was a free spirit with an audacious approach to life, never fearing, but loving, celebrating, and spending time with her soul mate, Corey, her younger brother Zavier, and her mother, with whom she communicated every day; and
