WHEREAS, on Saturday, May 21, 2016, Exaggerator was victorious in the 141st running of the Preakness Stakes at Pimlico Race Course in Baltimore, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, it was Kent Desormeaux's third Preakness Stakes win and his seventh career Triple Crown race; and

WHEREAS, his brother, Keith Desormeaux, who began his career in Maryland, experienced his first Preakness Stakes win after spending more than twenty years in horse racing's trenches; and

WHEREAS, Kent and Keith Desormeaux are two of Louisiana's finest sons from Maurice, Louisiana, and merit a special measure of commendation for their outstanding accomplishments in the sport of horse racing; and
