To commend and congratulate Phil Robertson on being named to the 2020 Louisiana Sports

Hall of Fame induction class.

WHEREAS, as an athlete in high school, he was all-state in football, baseball, and track, which afforded him the opportunity to attend Louisiana Tech University in Ruston, Louisiana, and play for the Bulldogs on a football scholarship; and

WHEREAS, when he was approached to play professionally for the Washington Redskins, he declined because football conflicted with hunting season; and

WHEREAS, satisfying his passion for hunting rather than being on the gridiron, he became an entrepreneur in a dilapidated shed, where he spent twenty-five years making duck calls from Louisiana cedar trees, building his first call from a piece of walnut in 1972; and

WHEREAS, from its humble beginnings, the Duck Commander brand has become a household name in quality duck calls and has branched off to make an array of other products, including DVDs, Duck Commander shotguns, Cajun-style marinade, and shows made for the small screen; and

WHEREAS, Phil Robertson and his family also starred in the wildly successful reality show, *Duck Dynasty*, on the A&E Network; and

WHEREAS, realizing the importance of education, Mr. Robertson later earned a bachelor's degree in physical education and a master's degree in education; and

WHEREAS, the successful career of Phil Robertson has rightly earned him a place among the many greats in the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame.
