COMMENDATIONS. Commends Charlotte Gates as a recipient of the Fulbright Fellowship.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend and congratulate Charlotte Gates on being the recipient of the prestigious  
3 Fulbright Fellowship.

4 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana has  
5 learned of the great honor bestowed upon Louisiana State University senior, Charlotte Gates,  
6 who has been awarded the prestigious Fulbright Fellowship; and

7 WHEREAS, Charlotte Gates, a psychology major and student in the Honors College,  
8 will graduate in May, 2010 and plans to pursue a Ph.D.; and

9 WHEREAS, the fellowship will allow Charlotte Gates to travel to Toulouse, France,  
10 where she will study the curious phenomenon of Synesthesia at CNRS, the National Center  
11 for Scientific Research, a field of study which is relatively new with only a few other  
12 prominent research centers in England, and Australia; and

13 WHEREAS, Charlotte Gates grew up in Shreveport, Louisiana, and graduated from  
14 Caddo Magnet High School; and

15 WHEREAS, each year the Fulbright Fellowship Program, which is administered by  
16 the United States Department of State and assisted by the Institute of International  
17 Education, allows more than one thousand one hundred Americans to study and conduct  
18 research in over one hundred forty countries; and

1           WHEREAS, the program is designed to give recent graduates opportunities for  
2 personal and professional development, including international experience; and

3           WHEREAS, study proposals may include university course work, classes in a music  
4 conservatory or art school, independent research, classroom teaching, or a combination  
5 thereof; and

6           WHEREAS, the success of our country, the strength of our communities, and the  
7 overall vitality of American society depend, in great measure, upon young adults like  
8 Charlotte Gates who continue to strive for a better tomorrow.

9           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana  
10 does hereby commend and congratulate Charlotte Gates upon being awarded the prestigious  
11 Fulbright Fellowship, and on her numerous outstanding achievements.

12           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be presented to  
13 Charlotte Gates.
